CITY REQUIREMENTS

As per Chapter 10, all electrical maintenance work performed on a property requires an annual maintenance permit to be held. All work performed under the electrical maintenance permit must be performed by a Licensed Maintenance Electrician or by personnel whose competence has been certified by completion of a minimum 8-hour training course approved by the Electrical Examining and Supervisory Board.

A FEW EXAMPLES

This means that as per the Electrical Code means that your commercial or residential maintenance personnel must be Registered Electrical Maintenance Technicians if they;

- Change ballast's for interior or exterior lighting
- Repair or replace 120 volt switches
- Repair or replace overcurrent devices
- Repair or replace ceiling fans, doorbell transformers, dishwasher motors ...and more

Work performed by a Registered Electrical Technician is limited to the maintenance of, repair or replacement of devices or lighting fixtures in or on existing outlets. No extensions or additions to an existing system are allowed with this certification.
